OMAN:

Medical Visa requirements for Indian embassy in Oman

Medical visa is admissible to all foreign nationals seeking Medicare in recognized specialty hospitals or treatment centers in India. Although non exhaustive, following illustrative list of serious ailments would be of primary consideration; neuro-surgery; ophthalmic disorders; heart related problems; renal disorders; organ transplantations; plastic surgery; joint replacement etc.

1. General guidelines for visa application are applicable in this case also.
2. However, additionally medical visa application form should be accompanied with a referral letter or preliminary medical advice from the Oman hospital, recommending specialized medical treatment abroad and a letter from the medical hospital in India, indicating appointment or showing willingness to undertake treatment.
3. The visa is granted for a maximum period of one year or for the period of treatment whichever is less for seeking medical attendance only in reputed/recognized specialized hospitals/treatment centers in India.
4. It is mandatory for the foreigners coming on Medical visa to get themselves registered well within the period of 14 days from the date of arrival with the concerned FRROs/FROs, in case the applicant is required to stay in India for more than 6 months for the treatment.
5. Such visa will be valid for maximum three entries during one year.

TANZANIA:

Medical/Medical Escort Visa:

The Medical visa is issued for the confide purpose of specialized medical treatment or treatment under the Indian system of Medicines. The validity of Medical/Medical escort visa may be up to a period of six month or one year or the period of treatment whichever less. Validity can be extended for a further by the State Government/ FRROs on the production of medical certificate/ advice from the reputed/ recognized/ specialized hospitals in the country.

Requirement for Medical Visa:

- Copy of preliminary medical advice stating that applicant needs specialised treatment and has been referred to hospital in India. Or
- Copy of letter of appointment with doctor in some recognised medical institution in India.
- Documentary proof of his financial standing.
- Attendant/family members escorting patient to India for medical treatment are granted medical attendant visa co-terminus with medical visa of the patient. Maximum two persons can accompany the patient as attendant/escort. Patient is issued Medical Visa while accompanying persons are issued Medical Escort Visa. Fee for both are same.
- Persons going on 'Medical visa' or 'Medical Escort Visa' will be required to get themselves registered mandatorily well within the period of 14 days of arrival in India with the concerned FRROs/ FROs.

KENYA:

MEDICAL VISA:

Documents required:

- i) Filled-in and signed hard copy of the online visa application form;
- ii) Two recent colour photographs;
- iii) Letter of invitation from an approved Hospital /Doctor in India;
- iv) Medical documents establishing the need for taking medical treatment in India;
- v) Proof of availability of sufficient funds for stay in India including the expenses for medical treatment by producing documents such as Bank statement, Salary certificate, sponsorship letter etc.;
- vi) Fee: Ksh.7600 + Ksh 200 towards ICWF for six months & Ksh.11400 + Ksh 200 towards ICWF for one year.

A Medical/Medical Attendant visa is normally issued in 3 working days, exclusive of the day on which application is made.

KUWAIT

VISA FOR KUWAITI AND FOREIGN NATIONALS

Medical Visa

Medical visa is admissible to all foreign nationals seeking Medicare in recognized specialty hospitals or treatment centers in India. Although non exhaustive, following illustrative list of serious ailments would be of primary consideration; neuro-surgery; ophthalmic disorders; heart related problems; renal disorders; organ transplantations; plastic surgery; joint replacement etc.

1. General guidelines for visa application are applicable in this case also.
2. However, additionally medical visa application form should be accompanied with a referral letter or preliminary medical advice from the Kuwait hospital, recommending specialized medical treatment abroad and a letter from the medical hospital in India, indicating appointment or showing willingness to undertake treatment.
3. The visa is granted for a maximum period of one year or for the period of treatment whichever is less for seeking medical attendance only in reputed/recognized specialized hospitals/treatment centers in India with complete address and phone numbers.
4. Attendant/family members of the patient coming to India for medical treatment shall be granted Medical Attendant visa co-terminus with the 'Medical Visa' of the patient. Such visa may be granted to the spouse/children or to those who have blood relations with the patient.
5. It is mandatory for the foreigners coming on Medical visa to get themselves registered well within the period of 14 days from the date of arrival with the concerned FRROs/FROs.
6. Such visa will be valid for maximum three entries during one year.

- Letter from the Ministry of Health and Quality of Life of the Government of Mauritius or hospital in INDIA INDICATING NAME, PASSPORT DETAILS AND DATE OF TRAVEL OF PATIENT AND ACCOMPANYING PERSON (IF ANY) TO INDIA FOR TREATMENT

ETHIOPIA:

Requirements for Visas

- Original passport valid for at least 6 months. The passport must have the holder's signature. If the passport is newly issued (within 6 months from the date of visa application), the previous passport also should be shown for verification. In case of dual nationality both the passports should be presented.
- Correct visa fee.
- Two passport size photographs (5 photographs in case of Pakistani nationals).
- Copies of supporting documents, passport and yellow fever vaccination certificate. All visa applicants going to India would have to undergo yellow fever vaccination 10 days prior to the application/departure.
- In case of visas for minors on separate passports, a consent/sponsor letter from the parents should be submitted.
- Duly completed application form. The visa application should be signed only by the applicant and it should tally with the signature in the passport. (Pakistani and Bangladeshi nationals need to apply on special application forms).

Please read all instructions on the application form carefully before filling it out.

Application forms should be filled up only in English, legibly and accurately.

Incomplete and illegible forms will be returned without service.

Fees

- The visa fees are to be paid in Birr and in cash only.
- Fees once received will not be refunded, even if the application is withdrawn or the service refused.

- Original passport and photocopies of relevant pages
- 6 months validity should be there in the passport
- Minimum 2 blank pages in the passport
- Online visa form filled up by the applicant and printed from the link : www.indianvisaonline.gov.in/visa
- GCC nationals must provide a copy of a valid photo ID issued from UAE
- UAE residents with Abu Dhabi or Al-Ain issued visa residing in Dubai/Northern Emirates must provide a copy of residency proof in their name (Tenancy contract, Electricity bill or Telephone bill).
